Reconciliation Grants

The deadline for requesting funds from the Central Area Reconciliation funds is November 1.

- Experimental programs which, if successful, could be used in other situations
- Local, area, or regional programs where there are insufficient funds available for funding
- Grants from the Central Area Reconciliation fund are for projects within the Area which are sponsored or advocated by at least one member congregation

Bean Month

October is designated for Bean Month. Annually, Central Area congregations are raising \$5,500 to purchase 11 tons of pinto beans for the Good Samaritan Refugee Center in Los Fresnos. The churches are encouraged to have fun planning a fund raiser in October. Only monetary gifts can be accepted.

Fund raising ideas:

- Beans & Fellowship Dinner-serve pinto beans & cornbread; decorate your tables with newspapers for placemats, mason jars filled with dried beans and sunflowers; freewill offering for Bean Month.
- Bean-Walk or Bean-Jump to raise money. Sponsors could commit to a flat fee or an amount per mile.
- Piggy Banks-take out 2008 pennies as your gift to Bean Month.

- Bean Cook-Off-Competition would include any dish containing beans-have a fellowship dinner with entries being judged and then the entries become the main dish for the dinner. Those not participating in the cook off would bring the side dishes. Participants would pay a fee to enter the cook off (secure a prize for the winner from a local business) and everyone else would give a free will offering.

2009 Summer Camp Dates and Rates

The Covenant Youth Committee met in September to evaluate the 2008 summer camps and make decisions for the upcoming 2009 events.

Rates at Lake Brownwood Christian Retreat will be increased, but the committee and camp directors put their pencil to the budget. Thanks to a generous gift from a member of First Christian Church in Stephenville, we are able to reduce every camper’s fee for the next three years in the amount of \$16.79 per camper.
