Kevin Hollowell has been in ministry 26 years and has served as the pastor of Central Christian Church in Winnsboro for 13 years, a record for the local church and for him personally.

Kevin has been married to Linda Hollowell, for 30 years. They have a daughter and son-in-law, Teri and Jeff Lehmann, and two adorable granddaughters, Rachel and Rebekah. Kevin and Linda had a son, David, who lost his battle with cancer at the age of 18 in 2003.

Throughout his ministry, Kevin has been active in the communities. He is the treasurer for Lions Club, Raider Pride, and Lonestar Chapter Softball Officials.

Kevin has encouraged the church he pastors to support the community as well. It has opened its doors for meetings, weddings, and receptions for people who are not members of the church. The church chartered the first Boy Scout Troop in town and continues to support it. The Blessing Box ministry has been a ministry of the church for 10 years and is a blessing to a variety of people within the community. It not only provides household and clothing items for people, but has been known to help pay for utilities, provide food, pay for school supplies, and act as a resource for many others.
